

1. Blue Cadet Merit Ribbon - This ribbon is awarded to cadet members who distinguish themselves, (1) by exceptionally meritorious service to the cadet program, or (2) by extraordinary acts of heroism under unusually hazardous conditions.

2. White Cadet Merit Ribbon - This ribbon is awarded to cadet members who attain a final grade of 90 percent or higher on the prescribed instruction comprising the Secondary Training of the CAP Cadet Training Program.

3. Red Cadet Merit Ribbon - This ribbon is awarded to cadet members who attain a final grade of 90 percent or higher on the prescribed instruction comprising the Basic Training of the CAP Cadet Training Program.

Note - Cadet Merit Ribbons: The award of the White Cadet Merit Ribbon will automatically supersede the Red Cadet Merit Ribbon. Only one of these ribbons will be worn at any one time. The Blue Cadet Merit Ribbon, if awarded, may be worn in addition to the White or the Red.

4. Blue Service Ribbon - This ribbon is awarded to senior members who have performed a total of at least 2,000 hours of honorable volunteer service in the Civil Air Patrol program, and who have been members of the Civil Air Patrol in good standing for at least six years.

5. White Service Ribbon - This ribbon is awarded to senior members who have performed a total of at least 1,000 hours of honorable volunteer service in the Civil Air Patrol program, and who have been members of the Civil Air Patrol in good standing for at least four years.

6. Red Service Ribbon - This ribbon is awarded to senior members who have performed a total of at least 500 hours of honorable volunteer service in the Civil Air Patrol program, and who have been members of the Civil Air Patrol in good standing for at least two years.


Note - Senior Service Ribbons: The award of a White Service Ribbon will automatically supersede the Red Service Ribbon and the award of a Blue Service Ribbon will automatically supersede the White Service Ribbon. Only the highest Service Ribbon authorized will be worn at any one time.

One, two, or all three of the following three ribbons may be worn by Senior Members. The award of any one does not supersede any other.


7. Distinguished Service Award - This decoration is awarded to senior members who distinguish themselves, (1) by exceptionally meritorious service in a duty of great responsibility which has contributed in high degree to the successful accomplishment of the mission of the Civil Air Patrol, or (2) by extraordinary acts of heroism under unusually hazardous conditions.

8. Exceptional Service Award - This decoration is awarded to senior members who distinguish themselves by exceptionally meritorious conduct in the performance of outstanding service. Such service must be clearly exceptional. A superior performance of the normal duties of a position will not alone justify the award.


9. Meritorious Service Award - This decoration is awarded to senior members who distinguish themselves by particularly meritorious accomplishments which are outstanding. The required service or accomplishment is less than that required for the Exceptional Service Award but must, nevertheless, be accomplished with distinction.



BLUE CADET MERIT RIBBON





WHITE CADET MERIT RIBBON




RED CADET MERIT RIBBON







DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD




EXCEPTIONAL SERVICE AWARD




MERITORIOUS SERVICE AWARD
