Right Breast.
CAP Command
Patch.
Centered,
approximately
above pocket
(Required)

Grade Insignia. Full color plastic encased sewn on horizontally, ½" from the shoulder seam.
Bars are parallel with the shoulder seam; oak leaves, and eagle's heads point towards the neck. Stars are worn centered on the shoulder, in tandem & pointing to the neck.
(Required)
Cadets and NCOs do not wear grade insignia with the flight suit.

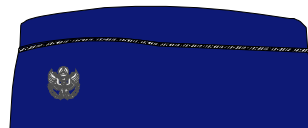

Military badges and insignia are authorized with this uniform and the height/weight and grooming standards apply. Insignia may be sewn onto the flight suit or affixed with Velcro.
