



THE CIVIL AIR PATROL BLUE FLIGHT SUIT

Grade Insignia. Plastic encased or full color on dark blue cloth sewn on horizontally, 1/2" from the shoulder seam. Bars are parallel with the shoulder seam; oak leaves, and eagle's heads point towards the neck. Stars are placed in the center of the shoulder, in tandem, pointing towards the neck. (Required)
Cadets and NCOs do not wear grade insignia with the flight suit.

HEAD GEAR

Not required but the CAP Base ball cap, CAP blue Patrol CAP, CAP Flight Cap & approved organizational baseball cap are authorized.

AUTHORIZED OUTERGARMENTS

- 1) CAP Black leather flight jacket

UNIFORM COMPONENTS:

FLIGHT SUIT: Dark blue Nomex flight suit with black or white crew-neck T-shirt. A black turtleneck may be substituted for a T-shirt.

FOOTWEAR: Black Combat Boots or black shoes.

Military badges and insignia are not authorized with this uniform and the height/weight standards do not apply. Insignia may be sewn directly onto the flight suit or affixed with Velcro.
