



THE CIVIL AIR PATROL DISTINCTIVE SERVICE UNIFORM MALE OFFICERS

SQUADRON/GROUP COMMANDER BADGE

Worn on the right pocket ½" above the nametag & centered
NOTE: Only sitting commanders may wear the commander badge. (OPTIONAL)

GRADE EPAULETS

Senior member officers wear CAP gray shoulder marks that slide onto the shirt epaulets. (REQUIRED)

AERONAUTICAL RATING & SPECIALTY INSIGNIA

May be miniature or full size. Worn ½" above the top row of ribbons. If ribbons are not worn, place the bottom badge ½" above the left pocket. Aeronautical rating and a specialty insignia or Specialty Track Badge are authorized for this uniform. They will be worn centered, ½" apart. Aeronautical insignia are always worn above the specialty insignia. EXCEPTION: The Chaplain insignia are worn above the aeronautical insignia. (OPTIONAL)
MILITARY BADGES ARE NOT AUTHORIZED FOR THIS UNIFORM

NAMETAG

Gray 3-Line nametag placed resting on, but not over right pocket, centered (REQUIRED)

THE "GIG LINE"

Keep the shirt edge, end of belt buckle and fly aligned at all times. This is the "gig line"

BELT

Black leather, no more than 2" wide with plain silver buckle (REQUIRED)

RIBBONS

Worn centered, resting on, but not over the top of the left pocket. Worn in rows of three. Ribbons are optional with this uniform. MILITARY AWARDS & DECORATIONS ARE NOT AUTHORIZED WITH THIS UNIFORM

SPECIALTY BADGE

Worn centered on the left pocket. ONLY ONE SPECIALTY BADGE IS AUTHORIZED WITH THIS UNIFORM (OPTIONAL)

AUTHORIZED OUTER-GARMENTS

There are no prescribed outer garments for this uniform. Outer garments should compliment the uniform.

AUTHORIZED HEADGEAR (REQUIRED)

None prescribed

UNIFORM COMPONENTS

SHIRT: White aviator shirt; no military creases or pencils/pens in the pockets.

TROUSERS: Medium gray slacks without pleats.

SHOES: Black low quarter shoes or black boots.

When wearing this uniform, height /weight and grooming standards do not apply.

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
