Captain Charles E. (Chuck) Corway is the administrative and personnel officer for the Addison Eagles Composite Squadron (SWR-TX-390) in Addison, Texas. He is responsible for managing the administrative and personnel affairs of the squadron's cadets and senior members and is also the senior advisor for the Texas Wing Cadet Advisory Council.

Captain Corway joined Civil Air Patrol as a cadet in December 1977, achieving the grade of cadet major and earning the Billy Mitchell and Amelia Earhart awards prior to entering the Civil Air Patrol senior member program in 1985 upon enlisting in the U.S. Air Force. He left the senior member program in 1988 and returned in October 2005.
