MEMORANDUM FOR ALL COMMANDERS AND LOGISTICS OFFICERS

SUBJECT: Prohibition Against CAP Screening of Battle Dress Uniforms (BDU)
Rescinded

1. General Courter is pleased to announce that after two years of work by CAP-USAF, NHQ staff and volunteer staff CAP is once again authorized to screen woodland BDUs from the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO). Commanders and authorized logistics personnel are authorized to accept these uniforms in accordance with CAP Regulations.
2. Commanders are reminded that only the woodland style BDU is authorized for CAP members. The desert style uniform is prohibited. Additionally, all CAP and Air Force regulations and policies must be followed in screening and accounting for these items. Wings should only accept enough uniforms for their own use. Wings with an excess of BDU uniforms should work with their State Directors and CAP-USAF Region offices to redistribute the excess to other wings.
3. Logistics officers must account for all BDUs when screened and issue them in accordance with CAP Regulations. Proper procedures must be followed to return unserviceable BDUs to DRMO. If you have questions regarding these policies, contact the National Controller, CAP/LG or your state director.
