VFW POST RECOGNITION OF CIVIL AIR PATROL CADETS

- ⇒ *If there is a Civil Air Patrol Program in your area, this is an excellent opportunity for your Post to be active in youth programs.*
- ⇒ *The VFW CIVIL AIR PATROL awards for special recognition of outstanding achievement and exceptional leadership ability are available for both Cadet Officers and Cadet NCOs.*
- ⇒ *The criteria and awards have been approved by the Civil Air Patrol.*
- ⇒ *The criteria for selecting the recipient of the VFW award for Cadet Officers and Cadet NCOs follow:*

CADET OFFICER AWARD

1. **Description.** A medal pendant with matching ribbon bar. The ribbon is 1 3/8 inches in width (overall white ribbon with blue stripe).
2. **Eligibility.**
 - a.) Cadet Officer, C/2Lt – C/Col.
 - b.) Criteria:
 - 1) Be in good standing academically.
 - 2) Progressing satisfactorily in the CAP Cadet Program.
 - 3) Demonstrated outstanding achievement in:
 - a.) Community Service.
 - b.) Cadet Program (Aerospace Education and Leadership).
 - 4) Demonstrated outstanding leadership in Civil Air Patrol.
 - 5) Must be of high moral character.
 - 6) Demonstrates a high level of professionalism in appearance and action.
 - 7) Patriotism, (Commander or member of color guard, drill team and actively promotes Americanism).
 - 8) Demonstrates growth potential (assumes higher levels of responsibility).
 - 9) Must not have been a previous recipient of the award.
3. **Administration.** The recipient of the award will be selected by the individual Civil Air Patrol squadron. A CAPF-120 with attached justification will be submitted to VFW HQ, Department of Youth Development, Scholarship and Recognition Programs with a courtesy copy to Group and Wing HQ. Each Unit will submit ONE cadet for this award.
4. **Presentation.** It is recommended that the award be presented annually at an appropriate ceremony such as Group Commander's Calls, open houses, Dining Out, etc...It is further recommended that a representative of the VFW present the award. This award is a "group level" award and should be co-presented by the Group Commander whenever possible.

CADET NCO AWARD

1. **Description.** A medal pendant with matching ribbon bar. The ribbon is 1 3/8 inches in width (overall blue ribbon with white stripe).
2. **Eligibility.**
 - a.) Cadet in grades, C/SSgt through C/CMSgt.
 - b.) Criteria:
 - 1) Be in good standing academically.
 - 2) Progressing satisfactorily in the CAP Cadet Program.
 - 3) Demonstrated outstanding achievement in:
 - a.) Community Service.
 - b.) Cadet Program (Aerospace Education and Leadership).
 - 4) Demonstrated outstanding leadership in Civil Air Patrol.
 - 5) Must be of high moral character.
 - 6) Displays outstanding military bearing and conduct both in and out of uniform.
 - 7) Patriotism, (Commander or member of color guard, drill team and actively promotes Americanism).
 - 8) Demonstrates growth potential (assumes higher levels of responsibility).
 - 9) Must not have been a previous recipient of the award.
3. **Administration.** The recipient of the award will be selected by the individual Civil Air Patrol squadron. A CAPF-120 with attached justification will be submitted to VFW HQ, Department of Youth Development, Scholarship and Recognition Programs with a courtesy copy to Group and Wing HQ. Each Unit will submit ONE cadet for this award.
4. **Presentation.** It is recommended that the award be presented annually at an appropriate ceremony such as Group Commander's Calls, open houses, Dining Out, etc...It is further recommended that a representative of the VFW present the award. This award is a "group level" award and should be co-presented by the Group Commander whenever possible.
