Terrain Database Cycle 16T1 (and previously released versions) do not accurately represent some elevations at Blackrock Island, Ireland, located at N54° 04', W010° 19'. This location may not trigger TAWS/Terrain alerts at expected altitudes and distances and will not be depicted accurately on the Terrain Page or Synthetic Vision Technology (SVT).

Nearest airports to the affected region:

- EIBT (14 nm)
- EIKN (54 nm)



PILOT ACTION

Exercise caution and maintain awareness of the surrounding terrain when flying near Blackrock Island.
